



The Department of Civil Engineering was established in 1995 with the aim of producing well-qualified graduate engineers capable of meeting the changing and ever expanding needs of the country. The total enrolment in the 4-year B.Sc. Engineering degree program is about 841. A class size of about 50 students is maintained for effective teaching.

There are now 32 full-time faculty members including five professors, three associate professors, nine assistant professors, fifteen lecturers. Six faculty members are on leave for higher studies. More full-time teachers will be on board as a general policy to increase the strength of the department, in teaching and research.

The Department of Civil Engineering has eight well established laboratories with modern equipment to support teaching and research activities in the permanent campus.

The B.Sc. Engineering degree offered by the Department of Civil Engineering, AUST, is officially recognized by the Institution of Engineers (IEB), Bangladesh. Graduates from AUST have a very good record of employment in various public and private organizations. Some of them did their post-graduate studies in Bangladesh and other universities in various countries all over the world.

The Department of Civil Engineering had also offered post-graduate program from 2011.
