



The Department of Civil Engineering was established in 1995. The total enrolment in the 4-year B.Sc. program is over 1000. A class size of about 50 students is maintained for effective teaching. The Department has established laboratories with modern sophisticated equipment on its newly built permanent campus. There are now 33 full-time faculty members including six professors, two associate professors, nine assistant professors and sixteen lecturers. Eight faculty members are on leave for higher studies.

The B.Sc. Engineering degree, offered by the Department of Civil Engineering of AUST, is officially recognized by the Institution of Engineers (IEB), Bangladesh. The main objective of this department is to offer program covering all important branches and disciplines of Civil Engineering. The department covers a wide range of course curriculum. The department has a Course Up-gradation Committee to revise the Course curricula of UG and PG studies. Twenty two batches have been graduated during the last thirteen academic years. A number of Graduates of this department are pursuing higher studies in BUET as well as in different countries of the world. Some of them are working in the reputed consulting and construction firms of the country. Several graduates have already got Ph.D. and M. Sc. degrees from universities of different countries and are working abroad. The department has a Board of Post Graduate Studies (BPGS) and a Board of under Graduate Studies (BUGS), to enhance the Departments strength in teaching and research.

The Department is actively involved in the activities of the national and international engineering professional bodies. Apart from the academic programs, the department organizes the comprehensive training on computer aided design, drawing and project management through Centre for Extension Service of the University. Moreover, the department is planning to offer materials testing and consulting services by using its laboratories equipped with highly sophisticated and modern equipments and highly qualified and experienced faculty members. The Department usually arranges field visit, study tour, seminars and organizes many programs to encourage the extra-curricular activities. The department has a Civil Engineering Society (CES) to organize any co-curricular or extracurricular activities in the department.
